from behind the arc, and uses this to his advantage. Whenever the defender looks to close out his three-point shot, he bursts past them to finish at the cup. On the other hand, if the defence sags off at all, Webb is more than capable of punishing the opposition from downtown.

He made an impact in limited minutes for the Sabres, and should thrive with increased game time in the INBL Pro.
